

NSS Community Outreach Report: Denap Village Visit

1. Program Overview

On **March 28, 2026**, the NSS unit of Nootan Pharmacy College (Sankalchand Patel University) organized a community outreach program at **Denap Village**, located in the Visnagar Taluka of Mehsana district. The camp was attended by B.Pharm Semester 4 students and supervised by Assistant Professor Mr. Dixit Solanki

2. Key Activities & Initiatives

The camp was structured to address healthcare awareness, child welfare, and environmental cleanliness. The following activities were successfully conducted:

- **Door-to-Door Community Survey:** Students interacted directly with the villagers, conducting a comprehensive survey to understand local demographics and prevalent health concerns. This provided students with practical insights into rural healthcare needs. If we look at the outcomes of this survey, we found that there were more people suffering from joint pain, knee pain, and back pain.
- **Anganwadi Engagement & Health Education:** Our volunteers visited the local Anganwadi to engage with young children. Through **interactive games** and storytelling, the students taught the children about basic hygiene and disease prevention, making complex health concepts easy to understand for the young audience.
- **Village & Lakeside Cleanliness Drive:** In alignment with the *Swachh Bharat* mission, students actively participated in a cleanliness drive. They cleared litter from the village streets and

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specifically focused on **cleaning the area surrounding the village lake**, significantly improving the local sanitation.

- **NSS Awareness Rally:** To conclude the field activities, a spirited rally was organized. Students marched through the village streets with banners and slogans, raising awareness about social responsibility, hygiene, and disease prevention.

3. Conclusion

The camp was highly productive, achieving its goal of sensitizing students to rural life while providing valuable service to the residents of Denap. The villagers and local authorities expressed their gratitude for the efforts of the Nootan Pharmacy College students.
